ISCC certification benefits for Food brands



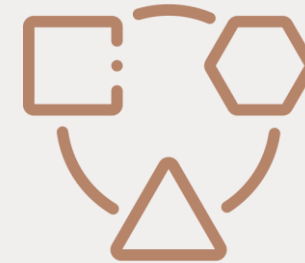
Brand Communication
