This fee structure applies to the ISCC fees related to the registration and certification process, while optional add-ons as well as ISCC fees not related to certification are detailed in further dedicated documents*.

Applicable Certification Schemes and Scope of Coverage

This Fee Structure applies to ISCC EU, ISCC PLUS, ISCC CORSIA, ISCC Japan FIT and ISCC Canada CFR schemes.

All relevant certified outputs are covered, except electricity and heat, which are subject to a separate addendum.

Fees for System Users (SU)

① Certificate Fee

The certificate fee is charged per Certificate issued, regardless of how many certification scopes are covered by the Certificate. The fee is calculated based on the total annual turnover of the legal entity to which the Certificate is issued. The total turnover includes both sustainable and non-sustainable material and covers all operations of the certified legal entity. Certificate fees are invoiced and to be paid to the CBs that transfer these fees to ISCC.

① Quantity-Dependent Fee

The quantity-dependent fee (QDF) applies to the amount of outgoing material that a System User declares as sustainable under the ISCC scheme. A separate QDF invoice is issued for each respective ISCC certificate. The fee is calculated individually for each certified scope, based on the quantities reported as outgoing under that specific scope in metric tonnes. It is invoiced retrospectively for each respective certification period, ensuring that only verified sustainable output is charged. The indicated quantity report period must correspond as closely as possible to the last certification period, and there must be no gaps between subsequent quantity report periods. Quantity-dependent fees are invoiced by and paid directly to ISCC.

① QDF Invoice Threshold

A minimum threshold of 300 € applies to quantity-dependent fees. If the calculated QDF for all scopes covered by the Certificate in the Certification Period is less than 300 €, no QDF will be charged. For System Users with ISCC Association membership, the threshold assessment shall be made after applying the 20% membership discount to the calculated quantity-dependent fee.

① Legal entities with ISCC Association membership

System Users who are registered members of the ISCC Association (including their fully owned subsidiaries) are entitled to a 20% discount on the total quantity-dependent fees. This reduction applies to the volume of sustainable material declared under each issued ISCC certificate.

Cost Breakdown for System Users

Certificate Fee = X
Quantity-dependent Fee = Y
Audit Fee (Charged by CB) = Z

Initial Certification = X + Z + (Optional Add-ons)
Recertification = X + Y + Z + (Optional Add-ons)

Quantity-dependent Fees are invoiced by and paid directly to ISCC.

Audit Fee, Certificate Fee and Add-on Fees are invoiced by and paid through the Certification Body.

Fees for Certification Bodies (CB)

① CB Certificate Fee

CB Certificate Fees are charged to the CB for each Certificate it issues under an ISCC certification scheme, regardless of the System User's turnover classification.

① CB Licence Fee

The CB Licence Fee is a one-time fee charged upon execution of the Cooperation Agreement between ISCC and the Certification Body. Certification Bodies with an existing Cooperation Agreement with ISCC are exempt from this fee.
